



The Indianapolis Symphonic Choir seeks a Production Specialist to oversee choir operations and production activities. As a member of the Choir's senior management team, and reporting to the Executive Director, the Production Specialist is the chief liaison for choir activities to the marketing, development, and finance teams in day-to-day operations. The selected candidate will possess strong management skills and operations experience along with knowledge of classical repertoire. The Production Specialist manages the production requirements of all choir events (concerts, rehearsals, and residencies) ensuring they run smoothly, effectively and in a financially responsible manner. The selected candidate will be responsible for increasing effectiveness of choir operations and serves as a strategic partner to the Artistic Director and Executive Director in the fulfillment of the Indianapolis Symphonic Choir's mission.

Responsibilities:

- Plan all choir services, in consultation with the Artistic Director and other artistic and production staff members
- Handle highly detailed production needs, including facility procurement, equipment rental, coordinating staging requirements and other logistical arrangements
- Coordinate and oversee activities with library staff, personnel, artistic staff, and the Conducting Fellow
- Supervise choir set-up for rehearsals and concerts and coordinate with the Artistic Director and production staff regarding any special set-up requirements
- Manage Chorus Connection portal and draft and disseminate weekly singer communications
- In consultation with the Artistic Director and Executive Director, maintain the Master Calendar and prepare and disseminate choir schedules
- Follow financial procedures of the Indianapolis Symphonic Choir, including preparing venue contracts for signature, processing concert invoices and reviewing production timesheets
- Develop and monitor budgets for all production and touring activities
- Coordinate Guest Artist travel, transportation and lodging and arrange for onsite hospitality
- Manage the procurement of supplies, licenses, equipment, instruments and services for operational purposes
- Maintain inventories of property and supplies
- Coordinate production requirements, timings and special needs for all taping, broadcasts and recording; serve as primary contact with recording engineers
- Coordinate activities of Development department for special projects involving the use of venues, stage crew and/or orchestra
- Manage volunteer program including 2-4 interns, administrative volunteers, artistic volunteers (section leaders, librarian, etc.)
- Other duties as assigned

- Experience working successfully with a variety of personalities including artists
